## Notes:

1. On Saturday altar servers may volunteer to serve priests' private Masses, but not during the pilgrims' principal Mass.
2. **Anthony Mitchell leads the altar servers. Anthony is to:**
  - (a.) Notify potential altar servers that only those young men who sign-up online using the webform at <http://national-coalition.org/w/altar-servers-sign-up/> are eligible for service with the *Corps of Eustace Ahatsistari* – the name of the servers' team.
  - (b.) Confirm with every server, no fewer than 10 hours before each scheduled Mass, all assignments: positions, time & location each Mass; and notify each server exactly where and when to be present & accounted for, and to bring the necessaries for serving Mass.
  - (c.) Then, to escort – or have his delegate escort – each server to his station to prepare for holy Mass.
3. Anthony Mitchell will **remind the altar servers** of Saturday and Sunday **to be present at the practices** held respectively Friday and Saturday evening after Dinner or at another convenient time to be announced. *One will not be able to serve without having attended the practices scheduled beforehand.*
4. **Extra servers, are to be encouraged to sign-up, to be present and to be prepared for possible replacements** in case someone does not show up, or is unwell.
5. ALL servers must wear a clean cassock, surplice, black socks, and black dress shoes. NO EXCEPTIONS ARE MADE.
6. All servers serving High or Solemn High Mass must arrive no later than 20 minutes before scheduled time of Mass unless their function demands them to be there earlier (e.g. MC, Thurifer).
7. Servers Thursday - Sunday are finally assigned pending Fr. Johannes' final approvals in the field.
8. Changes to the schedule in the field must receive the approval of Paul Audino, and finally the permission of Fr. Johannes.
9. The one-time customary Mass on Monday, the day after pilgrimage, has been again canceled.
10. Paul Audino serves this year as R.O. At-Large: sometimes in the past referred to as “super-sacristan” – whose responsibility is to coordinate for Priests, servers, Mass Set-up Team, choirs and Chief of Brigadiers to assure that all parties come to the altar prepared and on time.
