9:45 AM	arrive at Our Lady's Shrine of Martyrs, Auriesville NY Drivers park in the Visitor Center parking lot, between the Shrine Visitor Center and the grassy field (and picnic pavilion). greetings & orientation - Vice-Director for Sunday's Events - Mrs. T. DeMaster Use this time to use the restroom facilities, as needed.
10:15 AM	First shuttle departs to join up with the main column of pilgrims. Please remember to bring a picnic lunch! outdoors - spiritual talk for adults - Given by group's chaplain. catechism lesson for children - Given by chaplain or catechist.
11:00 AM	Last shuttle departs to join up with the main column of pilgrims. Remember to bring a picnic lunch! community cold lunch Provided as a courtesy, but you are welcome to bring a dish to share.
11:40 AM	outdoors - confessions, children's games 20 minute clean-up period
12:00 PM	Confessions continue. practice period for the songs and cheers of the pilgrimage
12:15 PM	15 minutes of preparation prior to step-off Please use this time to set up strollers, pack water, use facilities, etc. Final Confessions heard - continued later along the way.
12:30 PM	Step-off! Walk along Canal Trail to Ft. Hunter to meet main column of pilgrims, confessing, singing & praying 15 decades of the Holy Rosary. Greet the main column with each brigade's cheer, and follow the column back to the Shrine.
3:15 PM	solemn high Mass
after Mass	All pilgrims retrieve luggage, pack up, and say their good-byes - this year at the Shrine's Visitor Center parking lot. All pilgrims and pilgrim-organizers enjoy a warm meal at the picnic pavilion across the field from the Visitor Center & gift shop.
6:00 - 7:00 PM	Pilgrims pitch in to clean up pavilion, field, parking lot, bathroom areas, and rest of Shrine grounds.
