<b>9:45 AM</b>	<b>arrive at Our Lady's Shrine of Martyrs, Auriesville NY</b> Drivers park in the Visitor Center parking lot, between the Shrine Visitor Center and the grassy field (and picnic pavilion). <b>greetings &amp; orientation - Vice-Director for Sunday's Events</b> - Mrs. T. DeMaster Use this time to use the restroom facilities, as needed.
<b>10:15 AM</b>	<b>First shuttle departs to join up with the main column of pilgrims.</b> Please remember to bring a bag lunch! <b>outdoors - spiritual talk for adults</b> - Given by group's chaplain. <b>catechism lesson for children</b> - Given by chaplain or catechist.
<b>11:00 AM</b>	<b>Last shuttle departs to join up with the main column of pilgrims.</b> Remember to bring a bag lunch! <b>community cold lunch</b> Provided as a courtesy, but <b>you are welcome to bring a dish to share.</b>
<b>11:40 AM</b>	<b>outdoors - confessions, children's games</b> <b>20 minute clean-up period</b>
<b>12:00 PM</b>	<b>Confessions continue.</b> <b>practice period for the songs and cheers of the pilgrimage</b>
<b>12:15 PM</b>	<b>15 minutes of preparation prior to step-off</b> Please use this time to set up strollers, pack water, use facilities, etc. <b>Final Confessions heard - continued later along the way.</b>
<b>12:30 PM</b>	<b>Step-off!</b> Walk along Canal Trail to Ft. Hunter to meet main column of pilgrims, confessing, singing & praying 15 decades of the Holy Rosary. Greet the main column with each brigade's cheer, and follow the column back to the Shrine.
<b>3:15 PM</b>	<b>solemn high Mass</b>
<b>after Mass</b>	<b>All pilgrims retrieve luggage, pack up, and say their good-byes - again this year at the Shrine's Visitor Center parking lot.</b> <b>All pilgrims and pilgrim-organizers enjoy a warm meal at the picnic pavilion across the field from the Visitor Center &amp; gift shop.</b>
<b>6:00 - 7:00 PM</b>	<b>Pilgrims pitch in to clean up pavilion, field, parking lot, bathroom areas, and rest of Shrine grounds.</b>
