

STEPS TO INVITE A PRIEST TO MAKE THE PILGRIMAGE FOR RESTORATION

1. Invite the priest to come on Pilgrimage, *via* email, phone or – best – in-person.
 - a. Ask him to consider it seriously, and in prayer.
 - b. Ask him to form an intention to come on pilgrimage, if it please The Lord.
 - c. Ask him to let Our Blessed Lady, Mary - Mother of Christ, work out the details.
2. Ask him to be a chaplain to a particular brigade or division of the pilgrimage organization. (See this post for an [overview](#) of the pilgrimage administration.)
3. Ask the members of the brigade or division to pray for the priest by name, begging God's holy Will and Providence.
4. Give, or e-mail, to him the dates of the pilgrimage, and a link to the website.

5. Follow up to explain the purpose of the pilgrimage, [why his sacred Ministry is so needed](#) by pilgrims, [about brigade life](#), the particulars of your brigade, and the particular spiritual needs of your brigadesmen and women.
6. Ask the priest if you may [register](#) him on his behalf. Use the registration form.

Enter the following information to register him:

- i. his full name
- ii. his postal address
- iii. his e-mail address
- iv. his mobile - *not* for publication
- v. his age
- vi. name of his parish, and name of pastor or superior

Finally, enter voucher code “SACRED CLERGY” at check-out to register him *gratis* by Aug. 15.

7. Have your Chaplain communicate with First Chaplain – Fr. J. Favole, and brigadier to prepare for step-off. favolefr@pilgrimage-for-restoration.org
8. Inform the *Company of St. Rene Goupil's* Temporal Care of Priests Team to prepare to meet the priest's temporal-material needs. Write to ambsl@pilgrimage-for-restoration.org.
