Notes:

1. Joseph Lloyd has prepared the schedule, assigned, and will lead altar servers in preparation and in the field. He will thus –

- a. Notify potential altar servers in advance that only those young men who sign-up online using the webform at http://pilgrimage-for-restoration.org/altar-servers-sign-up/ are eligible for service with the *Corps of Eustace Ahatsistari* the name of the servers' team-Patron.
- b. Confirm & preview in detail with every server, *no fewer than 10 hours before each scheduled Mass*, all assignments: positions, time & location of each Mass; and notify each server exactly where and when to be present & accounted for, and to bring the necessaries for serving Mass.
- c. Then, to escort or have his delegate escort each server to his station to prepare for holy Mass no fewer than 20 mins, before the start of the scheduled sacred Services.

- 2. Joseph will, in advance of arrival at check-in, Sept. 25, **remind the altar servers to be present at the practices scheduled on this document**. A server will not be able or permitted to serve without having attended the practices scheduled beforehand.
- 3. Joseph will, in advance of arrival to check-in, list & assign **extra servers** to be present and to be prepared for possible replacements in case someone does not show up, or is unwell.
- 4. All servers must wear a clean cassock, surplice, black socks, and black dress shoes. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. All servers serving high or solemn high Mass must arrive no later than 20 minutes before scheduled time of Mass unless their function demands them to be there earlier (e.g. MC, Thurifer) or risk being replaced.
- 6. Servers Thursday Sunday are finally assigned pending approval of Joseph's *and* Fr. Favole's final approbation in the field.
- 7. Changes to the schedule in the field must receive the approval of Joseph *and finally the permission of Fr. Favole*, First-Chaplain.
- 8. **James Farinholt** serves this year as "Super-Sacristan" whose responsibility is to coordinate for Priest-celebrants, servers' R.O., Mass Set-up Team R.O., Choir Director, and Chief of Brigadiers to assure that all parties come to the altar prepared and on time. He also is responsible to direct the Communion count before each Mass and to report it to the Mass Set-Up Team's R.O. no later than five minutes before Mass.

He is also responsible to remind all parties of CSRG, brigade leaders, chior, servers and other pilgrim-servants to have cleaned & cleared all areas within sight of Liturgies before each Liturgy, beginning the night before, removing all items not positively needed for pilgrims or Liturgies. "Clean & cleared" means that all work with with James F. to pitch in with their fellows to help clean the areas under, around, *and beyond* the pavilions, so that no trash or disorder can be seen by those pilgrims in ranks, praying, when they look forward, left and right.
