Keeping to the schedule can seem a monumental task in itself! To make it easier, we've listed below some helpful tips that parents have given us over the years.

Helpful Tips for the Holy Family Brigade

- Take some time to look over the schedule in advance!
- Expect rain! It's very rare that we go a pilgrimage without some precipitation. A plastic sheet to kneel on during Mass, a rain cover for your stroller, ponchos, etc. come in handy almost every year.
- During meals, a pitcher for hot water is recommended for families, rather than going back and forth to the water pot for individual servings. Only hot water is served in the mornings, so foods like instant oatmeal, boiled eggs, etc. are recommended.
- If you have older kids walking in the main column, you'll find much easier to send them off in the mornings if they have pre-bagged lunches & snacks they can grab before step-off.
- Not every camp has a handy place to wash dishes, and the pace is pretty quick during the day. Paper & plastic products are great time savers.
- When packing a stroller, make sure it's the last thing in the vehicle and first thing out. Having a handy place to put a little one leaves your hands free to pack up a campsite, prepare lunch, etc.
- Keep lunch items in an easy-to-grab container! Lunch is eaten together upon arrival at each camp, and then immediately followed by the spiritual talk in the same location where we eat. Having a handy crate or tub you can carry over to the pavilion in a jiffy saves so much time!
- Expect moisture from condensation in your tent. Sleeping with a hat on can make all the difference in preventing a head cold, especially with children.
